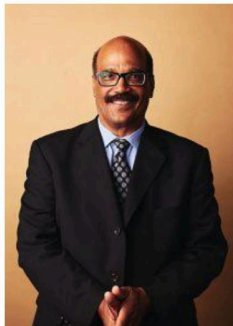

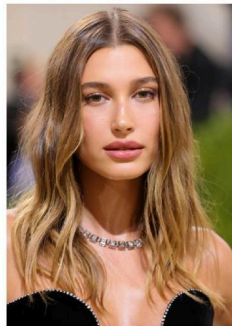

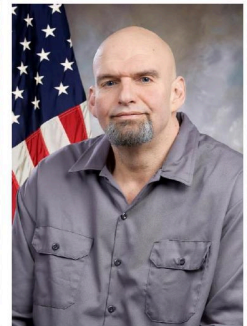

### Stroke & Aphasia in the Public Eye

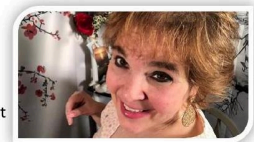
There is Media Coverage -Shining a Spotlight on our World!

RenéMarie's journey is truly inspiring! Founder and President of the Language of Love Foundation, RenéMarie, had a massive Stroke at the age of 26. After overcoming a massive stroke and dealing with aphasia at such a young age, she has turned her experiences into a powerful force for good. *"René Testa Adams was not too long removed from her days as an all-county athlete when the inexplicable happened to her on a softball diamond. She was coaching runners at third base, and at the end of an inning, she began to make her way to the dugout. In front of her players, the opposing team and everyone seated in the bleachers, her knees buckled and she collapsed to the infield dirt."*



*She was 26 years old, and she had just had a stroke. Now 59, she said what occurred to her on that day in April 1989 is easier to accept.
